

Àngela Nebot received her Ph.D. degree in computer science from the Polytechnical University of Catalonia (UPC), Barcelona, Spain, in 1994. She joined the Department of *Llenguatges i Sistemes Informàtics*, UPC, in 1994 as an Assistant Professor, and since March 1998 she has been Associate Professor in the same department. She is currently the head of the Soft Computing research group of the UPC. Her current research interests include fuzzy, neuro-fuzzy and genetic-fuzzy systems. The application areas include medicine, biology, atmospheric sciences and e_learning. She has published 17 articles in international research journals, more than 10 book chapters and more than 60 papers in international congresses.
