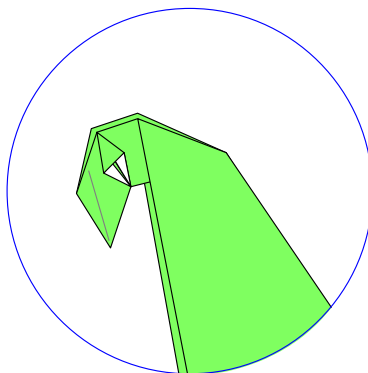

some paper for the beak.



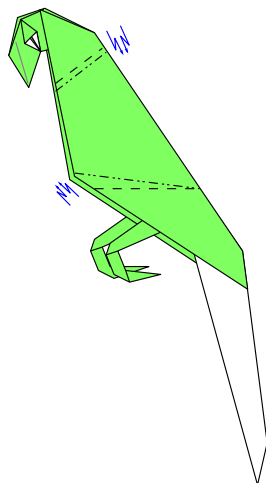

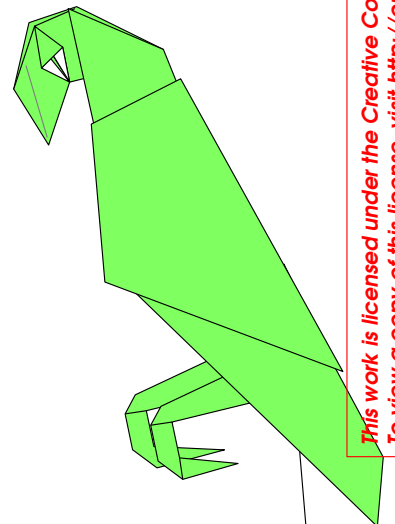
13 Squash to form the eye.
